ROLE & RESPONSIBILITIES

This is an unpaid role as Director for Tyne Theatre Productions (TTP) amateur production of SpongeBob the Musical which will be performed at the Tyne Theatre & Opera House (TTOH) during the week of 16 February 2026.

Tyne Theatre Productions sits under the Tyne Theatre & Opera House Community Engagement & Participation (CE&P) strand and is governed by a committee of in-house staff and Trustees. Members of TTP join via a subscription scheme and all administration will be handled by TTOH.

Key Responsibilities:

- To work with the Artistic Team to produce a high quality production of the above named musical in time for 6 public performances during the w/c 16 February 2026.
- To liaise with the Artistic Team and TTOH Head of CE&P on the audition process for cast members.
- To make artistic decisions on casting in partnership with the Music Director and Choreographer following a public audition process.
- To lead production rehearsals as part of an agreed rehearsal schedule between September 2025-February 2026, including evenings and weekends. *Please note that regular rehearsals are likely to be held on Wednesday evenings, and Sunday mornings*.
- To make artistic decisions for the above production in collaboration with the Chief Technician and any other internal staff.
- To work with internal technical staff on lighting and sound design.
- To report regularly to the Committee on technical requirements, budgeting, artistic choices etc.
- To make sure the production stays within the budget and agree any additional costs with the Committee ahead of purchasing.
- To participate in a post-production evaluation meeting
- To act as an ambassador for TTP in the North East during the rehearsal and production period.
- To share in the TTOH's commitment to protecting children, young people and vulnerable adults by being fully compliant with the venue's Safeguarding Policies, in addition to all other relevant venue policies

- Strong communication and relationship building skills and a consistently professional attitude
- Experience as a director of amateur or professional theatre productions
