TYNE THEATRE PRODUCTIONS – MUSICAL DIRECTOR

We are looking for a Musical Director for Tyne Theatre Productions (TTP) amateur production of **Annie** which will be performed at the Tyne Theatre & Opera House (TTOH) during the week of 14 February 2027. This production of Annie will include cast members from Tyne Youth Company.

Tyne Theatre & Opera House is one of a handful of remaining theatres in the UK that date from the Victorian period. A Grade 1 listed building, the theatre is unique in having one of the only surviving wooden stage machinery systems in the world. With a significant architectural and theatrical heritage, we are proud to have provided entertainment in the city of Newcastle for over 150 years.

Tyne Theatre Productions (TTP) is the Tyne Theatre and Opera House's in-house amateur dramatic company, managed within the theatre's Community Engagement & Participation strand. This role is rewarded by an honorarium fee of £1000.00 at the end of the production period. Members of the Artistic Team also receive a free TTP membership for the 26-27 season.

ROLE & RESPONSIBILITIES

Key Responsibilities:

- To work with the Tyne Theatre & Opera House and the *Annie* Artistic Team to produce a high quality production of the above named musical in time for 6 public performances during the w/c 14 February 2027.
- To conduct the full cast and orchestra for the above performances, including any warmups required.
- To ensure that the highest musical standards are maintained by both musicians and cast at all times.
- To prepare material for, and attend the TTP introduction evening on 6 July 2026, and the principal audition day on Saturday 18 July 2026.
- To liaise with the Artistic Team and TTOH Head of CE&P on the audition process for cast members.
- To make artistic decisions on casting in partnership with the Director and Choreographer following a public audition process.

- To lead cast music rehearsals as part of an agreed rehearsal schedule between September 2026-February 2027, including evenings and weekends, providing vocal demonstrations where needed. Rehearsals generally take place on Wednesday evenings (6.30-9.30pm) and Sunday mornings (10.30am-1.30pm) at a central Newcastle location.
- To develop an understanding of each cast members' vocal ability, supporting them to achieve the highest standard possible.
- To fix band musicians required by the production and confirm their details with the CE&P team.
- To conduct orchestra/band rehearsals as part of the agreed schedule.
- To attend Tyne Youth Company (TYC) sessions and collaborate with the TYC Musical Director to ensure rehearsal material is understood, artistically aligned and delivered on schedule.
- To provide internal staff with production information in a timely manner.
- To keep a record of all musical scores loaned out to cast/musicians and make sure these are returned to CE&P clean and by the requested deadline.
- To attend regular production meetings and additional meetings with theatre management as required.
- To liaise with the Head of CE&P regarding production budget.
- To support any shadow roles as requested by the Head of CE&P.
- To act as an ambassador for TTP in the North East during the rehearsal and production period.
- To share in the TTOH's commitment to protecting children, young people and vulnerable adults by being fully compliant with the venue's Safeguarding Policies, in addition to all other relevant venue policies.

Role Requirements:

- A passion for musical theatre
- Strong vocal or keyboard skills with the ability to sight read/sing
- Some experience in teaching and rehearsing
- Strong communication and relationship building skills
- A consistently professional attitude

We offer this role as a stepping-stone to industry entry for young/new creatives. You do not need to have MD'd previously.
